

Information on the processing of personal data in compliance with art. 13 of the EU Regulation no. 2016/679 - website-

Dear User, this policy is provided in compliance with the legislation on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data under EU Regulation 2016/679 (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulation").

- 1) **Aquatechnik Group Spa**, being the Data Controller, intends to inform you about the processing of the personal data you have provided.

The Data Controller guarantees that your personal data are processed in a lawful, correct and transparent manner, in compliance with the principles established by the Regulation, guaranteeing the protection of your data, your fundamental rights and freedoms.

- 2) Purposes and methods of processing: the processing of the data collected is carried out for the purposes expressed and in detail:
 - a) Reply to requests for information/contact;
 - b) Send news, updates, information communications and commercial proposals, advertising events and other direct and business marketing activities.

Personal data are collected electronically and will be processed with IT tools by our employees in compliance with the rules of confidentiality and security required by law.

- 3) Legal basis of processing: for the treatments carried out referred to in point 2) they are made possible only after expressing the consent necessary for point 2) a) while optional as regards point 2) b).
- 4) Optional nature of data provision and consequences of refusal: The provision of data for the purposes expressed above is optional; however, refusal makes it impossible to respond to the needs of the data subject.
- 5) Data Retention: The data collected will be stored and processed for the period necessary to achieve the purposes expressed and in particular to respond to the request for information. The data necessary for sending communications will be kept until the express consent is revoked and in any case no later than ten years from the date of the last successful communication.
- 6) Communication and dissemination scope: the data being processed will be communicated not only to our authorised personnel but also to external parties appointed as data processors for the purposes of managing and sending newsletters and site management.
- 7) Right of the data subject: in compliance with European Regulation, data subjects are entitled to the following: to ask the Data Controller to access their personal data (art. 15), to amend them (art. 16), to delete the same or to be forgotten (art. 17), to limit the processing of personal data concerning themselves (art. 18), to the right to data portability (art. 20) or to oppose their processing (art. 21), as well as to the right not to be subjected to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, which produces legal effects concerning themselves or which significantly affects their person in the same way (art. 22).

If the processing of personal data is based on the express consent of the data subject, pursuant to art. 7 paragraph 3 of the Regulations, the subject has the possibility to revoke his/her consents at any time.

The data subject is also entitled to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority in charge (Article 77 of the Regulation) if he/she deems that the processing carried out by the Data Controller is not compliant.
